

BEHAVIOR CONTRACT

Expectations

1. Follow the counselor's directions.
2. Always stay with the group.
3. Be courteous to others, this includes animals and plants. Remember to treat others as you would like to be treated. Keep your hands, feet and other objects to yourself.
4. Always talk to a counselor if you have a question or a problem during camp. We won't be able to help you if you don't speak up.

Failure to follow these expectations will result in an unsafe or unenjoyable atmosphere for you and others in camp. The Tennessee Aquarium has the right to remove a camper from camp at any time. Consequences for inappropriate behavior will be administered in the following sequence*:

1. Counselors will discuss the behavior with the camper.
2. The camper will be given a "time out" or will not be allowed to participate in a subsequent activity.
3. Counselors will discuss the behavior with the parent/guardian.
4. The child will be sent home immediately or told that he/she/they will not be allowed to return the following day.

*If a camper's actions are severe, steps may be skipped within this sequence.

Note: There are no refunds when a child's own behavior requires he/she/they be sent home.
