Tennessee Aquarium Camp Covid & Health policies

- Aquarium education programs are following CDC recommendations for schools. This means that indoor mask requirements will be determined by current covid community transmission levels. When transmission levels are at green or yellow, masks will not be required for campers or camp staff. At red levels, masks will be required indoors for all campers and camp staff regardless of vaccination status. - Please note that certain activities within the Aquarium may require masks for the safety of our animals. Campers will be notified of these activities prior to them taking place.
- If a camper is not feeling well and/or displaying symptoms of any illness, please keep your camper at home. Campers will be sent home if symptoms develop during the camp day.
- If a camper has close contact to a person who has tested positive for covid, that camper will need to remain home for 5 days post possible exposure and be symptom free before returning to camp. If the camper is unable to participate in their registered camp, attempts will be made to reschedule them into another camp experience as availability allows.
- If a camper receives a positive covid test result during their camp week, the camper will remain home, and the camp group that camper was part of will be canceled for the week. Attempts will be made to reschedule campers who wish to as availability allows in later weeks. Refunds will be given to anyone who cannot or chooses not to reschedule.
- If multiple campers receive positive results within multiple groups, those groups or, depending on exposure risk, the entire session will be canceled for the week. Attempts will be made to reschedule campers who wish to as availability allows in later weeks. Refunds will be given to anyone who cannot or chooses not to reschedule.

Please note our policies and procedures could change as guidelines from both CDC and the State of Tennessee/Hamilton Country update their policies.
