



Aqua Camp Scholarships

The Tennessee Aquarium is offering an exciting summer experience for youth in the greater Chattanooga area. Throughout the summer, the Tennessee Aquarium will make a limited amount of scholarships available for children to participate in summer camp programming. All scholarships may subsidize between 75%-90% of the program fee; awardees that are offered a partial scholarship will be required to pay any remaining balance.

The Tennessee Aquarium awards scholarships to families and individuals based on their financial need and available space.

Below are the guidelines:

- Only submit one application for all individuals within the same family.
- Applicants are eligible for a maximum of 1 week of camp.
- Applications must be submitted online by Friday, April 13, 2024 to be considered.
- Scholarships may be subsidized between 75%-90% of the program fee; awardees that are offered a partial scholarship will be required to pay the remaining balance. Remaining balances are based off of the non-member camp rate.
- All applicants will be notified via email or phone of their status by Friday, May 3, 2024. Please do not email or phone about the status of your application.
- If you are awarded a scholarship, your awards letter will have specific instructions regarding registering your camper. If there is a remaining balance, all balances must be paid at least 7 days prior to your selected camp date.
- The Tennessee Aquarium will provide daily lunches, snacks, and one T-shirt. If your child has special dietary needs, we highly suggest you pack snacks and a lunch daily.

Scholarships are awarded FIRST by Space Available. SECONDLY, by the level of Financial Need, and THIRDLY, by the date the application is received. Please send:

- Documentation of eligibility/participation in free and reduced lunch program or other government assistance MUST be attached to your online application.
- If you do not have these item(s), we still encourage you to apply!
